



Layer hens in battery cages have a life expectancy of about 7 years



A chicken reared in a battery cage lays less than 100 eggs a year



In battery cage farming of layer hens, male chickens (cocks) are killed when they hatch



To get whiter meat, calves intensively reared are deliberately made anaemic



Numerous industrial pig farms have polluted water tables



An artificial light is kept on for 12 to 16 hours a day in battery cage farming
